Overview

Encourage fine motor development with this quick and easy spider web craft made from yarn, felt, and canning supplies.

Prep

From M.E.C.C.A Teacher Resource Center

- Metal canning lid (screw band and flat)
- Fabric scrap, black
- Yarn, white
- Spider
- Glue

1. Cut fabric scrap so that it is an inch or so larger than the canning lid
2. Cut yarn to long lengths, about 12 inches

Project Directions

1. Separate the two sides of the canning lid. (The top piece is the screw band, the bottom piece is a flat solid circle).

2. Add glue to the inside of the ring.

3. Lay fabric on flat surface

4. Create a loop of yarn, then place over your fabric

5. Place your screw band on top

6. Flip everything over, then press the flat lid into the fabric, securing the fabric and yarn in between the screw band and flat lid

7. Using one of the ends of the yarn, wrap the yarn from the top to the bottom of the hoop, so that yarn divides the hoop in half.

8. Gently turn the hoop and wrap the yarn down the middle again.

9. Repeat until it looks like a web.

10. Knot the yarn off in the back to finish.

11. Use your glue to attach the spider, then proudly hang on your wall!
