## Overview

Turn old magazine images into useable works of art! This craft is easily adaptable to highlight anything from animals to flowers (or really, anything)!

## Prep

### From M.E.C.C.A Teacher Resource Center

- Cardstock
- Magazine photo (elephants shown here)
- Yarn, gray
- Beads, wooden
- Charms, elephant

1. Cut cardstock to 2"x7" rectangles
2. Collect magazine images; Optional: pre-cut images to 2"x7"
3. Cut yarn to 12" in length

## Project Directions

1. Start by cutting the image to 2"x7" (if not already cut); use cardstock as a guide.
2. Line the back of your image with school glue.
3. Use a hole punch to make a hole at the top of one of the short (2") sides.
4. Tie one end of the gray string to the top hole in the bookmark, and double knot it so it stays in place.
5. Add beads and charms, as desired.
6. Tie off the string on the end with a double knot and trim the ends.
7. Let dry before using your bookmark in your favorite book!
