- · Craft Paper, purple
- · Cardstock, yellow
- · Coffee Filter, white
- · Chalk, white
- 3D Bats, black
- · Glue dots or School glue

Optional: Pre-cut bat shapes to be used as 3D Bats (see template below).



### **Educator Lesson Plan**

# **Project Directions**

- 1. Use scissors to cut around the edge coffee filter (this is your moon).
- 2. Use school glue to glue the white coffee filter onto the yellow card stock.
- 3. Lay purple craft paper on your work surface.
- 4. Glue your moon onto the purple paper (yellow side up).
- 5. Use the long side of the chalk to make streaks all over the top half of your paper. Use your fingers to rub the chalk to make it look "foggy".
- 6. Decorate your mural with star stickers, and use glue dots to attach bats and all of your found nature items!
