Prep

From M.E.C.C.A Teacher Resource Center

- Cardstock (to print 5x7" template)
- Scrap papers: blue, teal, green, purple
- Acrylic paints: red, pink, orange, yellow
- Grass looking materials: moss, paper filler
- Buttons and stickers
- Toilet paper roll

Tools & Workspace Requirements

- Clear sealant (like Mod Podge)
- Tacky glue or hot glue gun (with adult supervision)
- Scissors

Project Directions

1. First, prepare your paper roll petals. Cut paper roll into six rings, pinching the sides together at each end to make a petal shape.
2. Paint the flower petals inside and out; set them aside to dry.
3. Tear your scrap paper into small pieces and set them aside.
4. Place glue on the cardstock template where you want to place scrap paper. Continue to glue scrap paper down in a mosaic pattern to fill in the background around the flower.
5. Cover scrap paper mosaic with a coat of Mod Podge and let dry.
6. Place your paper roll petals on top of your card in a flower shape. Then add a thin line of glue to the bottom edge of one petal and place it down on the card. Repeat for the remaining petals.
7. Glue down your grassy material at the bottom of the card.
8. Finish decorating your flower by adding stickers inside and outside the paper roll petals. Glue a shiny button or jewel in the middle of your flower!
