- Toilet Paper Roll
- Plastic Egg
- Acrylic Paint, white
- Clothespins, 3
- Stickers (circles, stars, flags, etc.)

Tools & Workspace Requirements

- Paintbrush

Optional: For an added sensory activity, fill plastic sandwich ziplock bags with a small amount of acrylic paint.

Project Directions

0. For sensory activity: Snap plastic egg together and put inside a ziplock bag. Use fingers to push the egg around inside the bag until coated in paint; place on scrap paper and let dry.

1. Paint the toilet paper roll.

2. Clip the clothespins to the bottom edge of the top so that the rocket ship is balanced.

3. Place the plastic egg inside the top of the tube.

4. Accessorize your rocket ship with stickers and drawn decorations!
